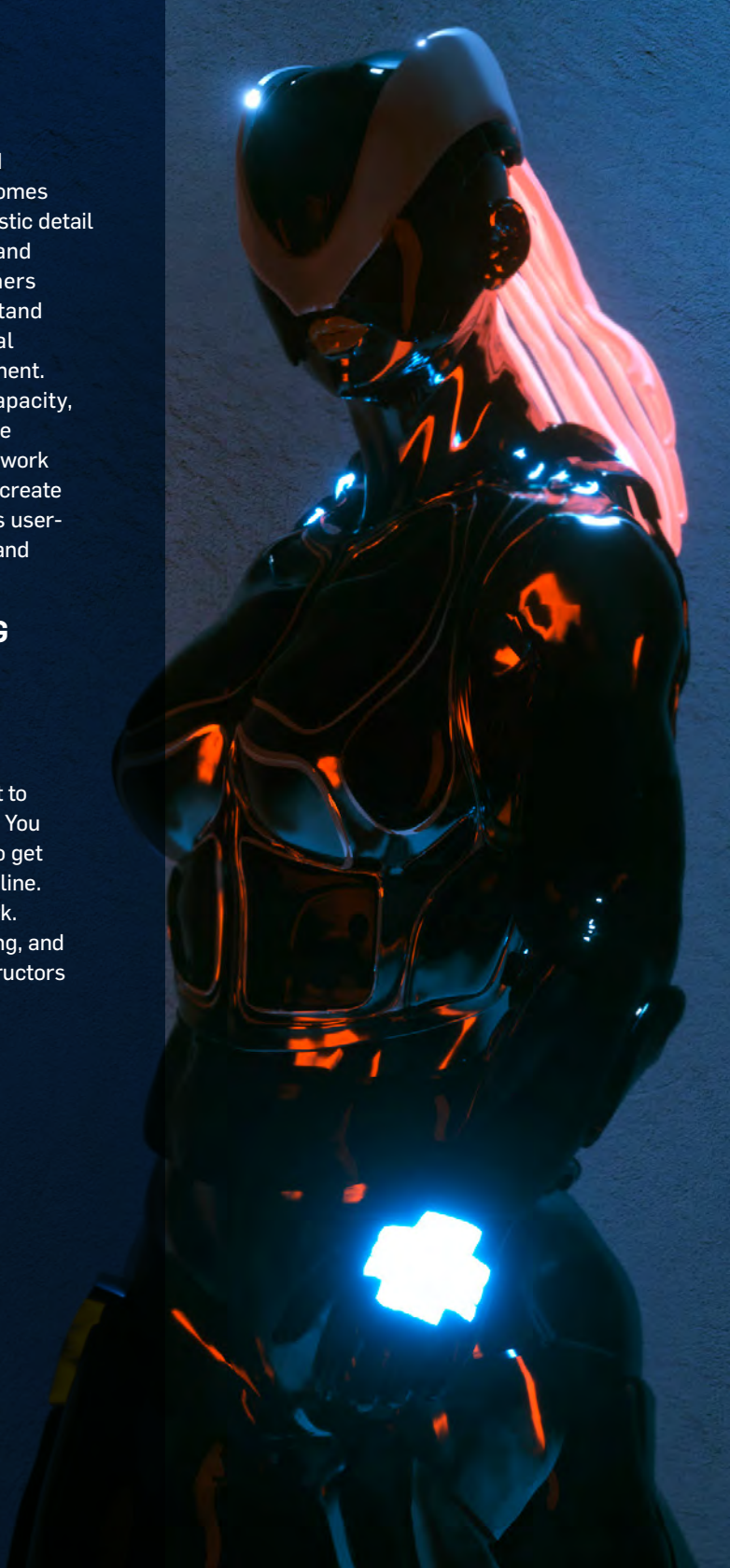

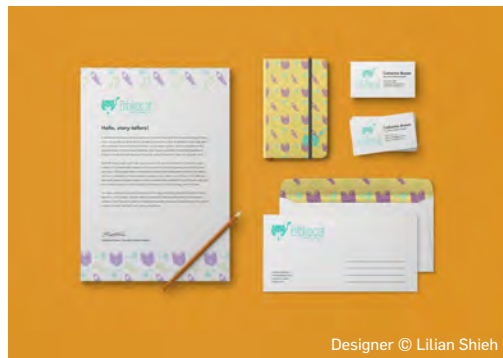
GRAPHIC DESIGN

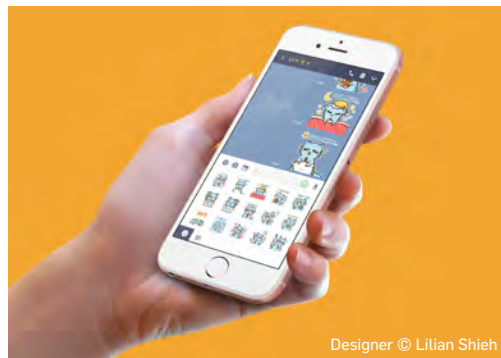


INTERIOR DESIGN

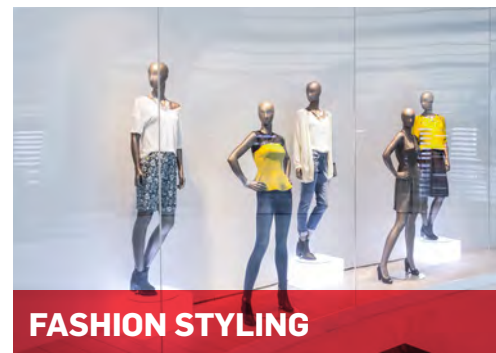

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

DOMESTIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

We'll guide you through the admissions process, which starts when you submit an application and your High School transcript.

A domestic student seeking to enroll at LaSalle College Vancouver must submit each of the following items:

- ☐ A completed and signed Application for Admissions Form
- ☐ A completed and signed Enrollment Agreement
- ☐ Admissions Fee
- ☐ A photocopy of a government-issued photo ID
- ☐ Proof of English Language Proficiency
- ☐ Admissions Orientation (in person or over the phone) with an Admissions Advisor
- ☐ Financial Appointment with a Financial Advisor
- ☐ Official copies of High School transcripts. Post-Secondary transcripts are only necessary when transfer of credit is a possibility. For transfer of credit, official transcripts will need to be provided along with course syllabi to be evaluated by the Admissions Committee.

** Other requirements may vary by chosen program.*



INTERNATIONAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

International admission requirements are for students who are neither a Canadian citizen nor an official permanent resident of Canada nor a convention refugee. All international applicants to LaSalle College Vancouver must meet the same admission standards as all other students.

An international student seeking to enroll at LaSalle College Vancouver must submit each of the following items:

- ❑ A completed and signed Application for Admission Form
- ❑ A completed and signed Enrollment Agreement
- ❑ Admission Fee
- ❑ A photocopy of the student's passport
- ❑ A photocopy of the student's valid study permit (for international students already present in Canada)
- ❑ Admissions Orientation to be completed either by telephone or at our campus location
- ❑ Official copies of all educational transcripts (secondary school and, if applicable, university level academic records) and diplomas. These educational transcripts and diplomas must be prepared in English or include an official English translation; for transfer of credit, official transcripts will need to be provided along with course syllabi to be evaluated by the Admissions Committee.
- ❑ Proof of English Language Proficiency (refer to box below and next page for details)

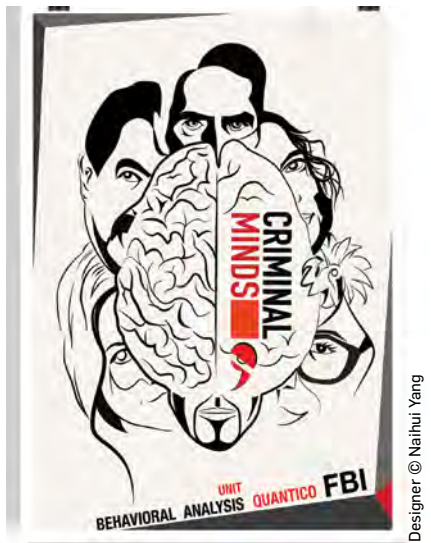
